

Hot Weather

On days of extreme high temperature, 36 degrees or above, the children will remain indoors at lunch time.

Front Office Staff will indicate hot weather supervision after a check of the temperature on the Weather Bureau website at 12.45pm.

Hot weather will be indicated by two sirens at the beginning of lunch (12.50pm)

Rain

If it begins to rain during recess or lunch time the teacher doing yard duty in Area 2 will advise the front office staff to signal wet weather by two siren sounds. Students will remain inside for the rest of the break unless rain clears with 10 minutes or more of play time remaining.

If students have not been outside from the beginning of the break and the rain stops, the bell will ring for them to go outside and normal yard duty will take place. If it rains again, Area 2 teacher will advise the front office staff to ring the siren and students will return to their classroom where they will remain for the rest of the break if less than 10 minutes or more of play time remains.

The library will remain open. Children can be sent to the library with by negotiation with class teacher and Librarian.

Supervision when Hot/Wet weather policy takes place

Class teachers will supervise their classes. A 'buddy' system will be established each year within individual units. Use of the 'buddy' system will allow teachers a break if needed.

Leadership and N.I.T. providers will assist with supervision where possible
